



TRANSITION TO SCHOOL

JUNE 20th 2024 – Parent Information Evening

Welcome to Reckleford Infant School parents meeting

We meet together on Thursday 20th June at 5pm to visit the school and meet the staff. You will be provided with your child's starter pack and bookbag. This is also an opportunity to ask any questions you may have.

JUNE 2024 – Pre-School visits

Mrs Pincott will visit your child in their Pre-School setting

We will endeavour to visit your child in their pre-school. This allows us to see your child in a familiar setting and have a chat with their Key Worker to get to know your child before they start in September.

JULY 2024 - Stay & Play Sessions

Visits to school - Wednesday 3rd, 10th and 17th

VISIT 1 Wednesday 3rd July 9:10-10am

Families are invited for a stay and play session to see the classroom, meet the class teacher and teaching assistant. On the visit you are welcome to stay with your child.

VISIT 2 Wednesday 10th July 9:10-10am

Children invited to come and play. They will be exploring the classroom, indoors and outdoors, and getting to know their new teachers. Parent/carers to have tea and coffee in the hall with Mrs Greathead.

VISIT 3 Wednesday 17th July 9:10-10am

Children invited to the stay and play session. This time parents please leave your child with us, as long as your child is happy and settled.

July 2024 - Home visits

Friday 5th and 12th July

Two members of Squirrel Class will visit your family in your home at a prearranged time. This visit is relaxed and informal, often sharing stories about your child, allowing the child to see the relationship between practitioner and parent. Any questions are answered, concerns eased, and every effort is made to ensure both child and parent are confident and happy to start school.

September 2024 - Home visits

Wednesday 4th and Thursday 5th September

If we have not had the opportunity visit you in July we will arrange a visit to your home during these two days.

September 2024 - Starting School

Monday 9th September 2024

We have a staggered start to school. This enables the children to start school in small groups, with a focus on building positive, effective relationships with the teachers, classroom staff and making new friends. As well as understanding the rules and routines of school. Children will be in groups, A or B, for the first week only and will follow the this timetable:
